Moisture management is the foundation of a successful tiled bathroom. Moisture sensitive construction materials must be protected from water and vapor penetration. Leaks and mold continue to pose serious problems for the construction industry. The fundamentals of both approaches, including proper design, execution, and function will be presented, with close attention paid to common errors.
